# **Guest Speakers**

We were very lucky in February to have two guest speakers come in and speak to our grade one students. On Wednesday, Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> Cst. Melanson came to speak to our students about train safety and the dangers of playing on and near trains. Later in the day we were fortunate to have Phillip McGee, a fourth year Nursing student speak to our students about Nutrition.

## In our Classroom....

#### Literacy

During February we continued working on all of the tasks in the Daily Five. My students really enjoy "Rainbow Writing" when they choose Word Work. I was also able to introduce 2 new Café strategies to help students when they get stuck on a word. In Writer's Workshop, we began introducing the 6 + 1 Traits of Writing, with our focus on the trait of Word Choice. My students have done a great job recognizing and beginning to use stronger word choices in their writing. We will continue working on this trait in March. In addition, we will begin focusing on the Conventions trait. It is important that grade one students begin to recognize and understand the importance of using conventions (periods, commas, question marks, etc.) in their writing.

#### Math

We will finish our unit on Numbers to 100 and begin our unit on Addition and Subtraction to 20. The school sites are back up and running and I added a couple new links to some more Math games. Although we are starting our new unit, it is very important for students to continue working with numbers to 100 (i.e. counting by 2's, 5's and 10's; counting forwards and backwards starting and ending with different numbers)

#### You and Your World

We will continue our unit on communities, this month focusing on Aboriginal people. We are hoping to have a special guest speaker later this month to share some cultural knowledge with our students. We will also be further exploring the differences between wants and needs of both individuals and their communities.
