Science-We will be finishing up our unit on Plants. Students are now watching their seeds, watering them and writing observations.

Social Studies- Grade 3 will be starting a unit on New Brunswick which will include mapping, studying its relation to the other Atlantic Provinces, Quebec and United States.

Daily Five- This literacy program is enhancing their reading and comprehension. Word Work is helping them with spelling, adding endings, also understanding the meanings of new words.

Writing- Grade 3 is very lucky to have Mrs. Sandy Bruce doing a **Writing Workshop** with our students. They are learning to follow a plan to help organize and add essential details to their stories.

Math- Grade 3 is now working on the unit "Numbers to 1000". In this unit students learn to read 3 digit numbers and put them in order from greatest to least and least to greatest. They are counting by 5's 10's 100's. They are using a hundreds chart to count by 3's and 4's. Students also learn to use the number-line to add larger numbers. Facts- We are working on multiplication facts 0 to 5. If possible we will do others.
