
Another way to multiply is to add groups to facts you know.

➤ Use facts with 2 to multiply by 3.

First, multiply by 2.

Then, add another group.

To find 3×7 :




So,
$$3 \times 7 = 21$$

➤ Use facts with 5 to multiply by 6.

First, multiply by 5.


Then, add another group.

To find 6×7 :



So,
$$6 \times 7 = 42$$

➤ Use facts with 5 and 2 to multiply by 7. Break the 7 into a fact with 5 and a fact with 2. To find 7 × 8:



So,
$$7 \times 8 = 56$$
