A Few Reminders

Wow; hard to believe, but here we are with one month in already!! Where has the time gone??!! We would like to remind you of the following few very important points to keep in mind: □ When your child is absent from school, please

send **a dated, signed note** explaining why he/she was out.

Please send any monies to school in a wallet or baggie labelled with your child's name and a note explaining for what the money is intended.
Children need to be signed in when arriving late for class and must be signed out when being picked up early by a parent.

□ Please **inform the school right away** of any change in address or phone number throughout the year.

□ Bussing: Students are not permitted to travel on a bus other than that assigned without a bus pass, which requires a signed note from home and the permission of the District Transportation Manager/ Officer. In order for a pass to be granted, sufficient time must be allowed to make the necessary contacts and gain approval from D.O. Please understand that, without the aforementioned, teachers are required to send children home on their regular bus.

Unless we have a note students will be going to their regular place after school for safety reasons. Please send a note in the morning in the agenda as it is a worry for the teacher and the student if they are not sure where they are to go after school.
