Literacy

Last month our class began the Daily Five, which consists of 5 different literacy tasks that have been found to be most effective in increasing literacy skills and enjoyment of reading and writing. Students learned the first task, "Read to Self" and have worked very hard. I am so impressed with how quickly my students increased their reading stamina! We did so well that I was also able to start "Read to Someone" during September! We will continue working on these 2 components of Daily Five during the month of October.

We also began Writer's Workshop last month, starting with a unit called *Launching the Writer's Workshop*. We will continue this unit during the month of October.

Math

We finished our first unit in mathematics on patterns. We started our second unit on Numbers from 1-20. We will continue with the concepts identified in the parent letter sent home last weeks. We have started to implement weekly Math Centers with Mrs. Pinder's grade one on Friday afternoons which has been lots of fun.
