## In our Classroom....

### Literacy

I am very excited to start the Daily Five this month! Some of your children may have been introduced to this program last year in Kindergarten and for others it will be new. The Daily Five is a way of structuring the literacy block so every student is independently engaged in meaningful literacy tasks. These research based tasks are ones that have the biggest impact on student reading and writing achievement, as well as help foster a love of reading and writing. Your children will receive explicit whole group instruction and then have independent practice time to read and write while I provide focused instruction to individuals and small groups of students. I am excited about giving your child the opportunity to be involved in a structure that will have such a positive effect on their education!!

We will also begin Writer's Workshop this month, starting with a unit called *Launching the Writer's Workshop*. I am looking forward to learning more about your children through the stories they write and share about their lives!

### Math

We will soon be starting the first unit in mathematics and will be learning about patterning. We will be learning to identify and copy patterns, as well as creating and extending our own patterns. Your children will also be learning to talk about how patterns repeat and will begin to solve problems using patterns. It is a hands-on unit and should be lots of fun!

### You and Your World

It will be a very busy month for You and Your World!! We will be covering Bus Safety, Playground Safety and Fire Safety. We will also learn more about bullying and what it means to be a good friend through books and various activities. Mr. Murphy will also be in our class to help implement a new program called I-Care.
