Thinking of Volunteering?

Anglophone North School
District welcomes the
participation of volunteers at all
levels and values the work done in
our schools by volunteers.

However screening procedures are important for the protection of students and volunteers. As part of District Regulation 206, all volunteers, must complete a Volunteer Screening Declaration Form. As well volunteers at the K -5 level, having unsupervised access to pupils, must provide a criminal check form.
